Komaiko, Leah.

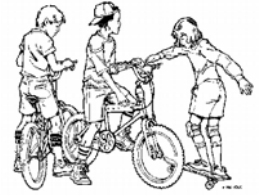
***Annie Bananie Best Friends to the End.*** J FIC KOMAIKO
