

The Library **Protects Your Personal** Information



In order to keep the personal information in your library account private, we can no longer add or change any information remotely, whether via phone, email, or text. As an additional security measure, you must have a password to connect to your account online.

The best way to create or change your password is to have a valid email address attached to your library account. With this, you can easily get a new password via your email, just like you would with Amazon.com or any other secure site. Once in your account online, you can reserve and renew items, opt-in to auto-renewal, and download free e-books and e-audiobooks through Live-brary.com.

If there isn't already an email address associated with your account, you must come in with proof of ID to add your email address and/or password.
