

SPECIAL: PURPOSES AND OBJECTIVES OF THE COMMUNITY LIBRARY

The Community Library's purpose and function is to provide library service to the entire population of the William Floyd Union Free School District. The wide variety of services offered should give opportunity for the education, cultural enrichment and development, recreation and entertainment of citizens of all ages from infancy through the senior years.

Immediate objectives which will enable the Library to fulfill this purpose and function are as follows:

- 1) To offer the services of the Library at a strategic location or locations throughout the District so that all citizens have reasonable access to its facilities.
- 2) To provide general reading materials, audio-visual materials, reference and information materials and other library services—including programs – for all ages. The means to this end is to build a stronger collection of all kinds of materials and make the Library an important center for information.
- 3) To provide programs that will enlighten and enrich residents of all ages.
- 4) To improve and enhance the public image of the Library in the community and acquaint the public with its many services.
- 5) To strengthen and improve the library staff so that the best possible services can be available to citizens.
