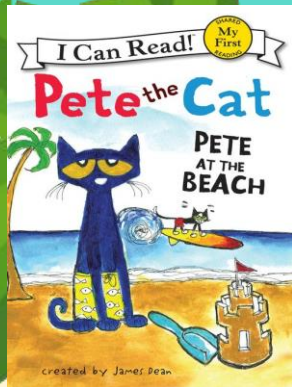
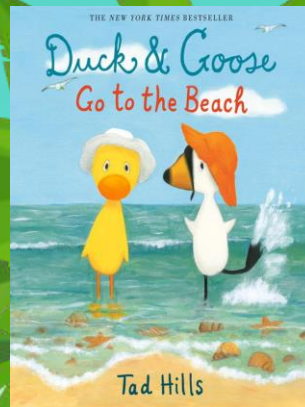

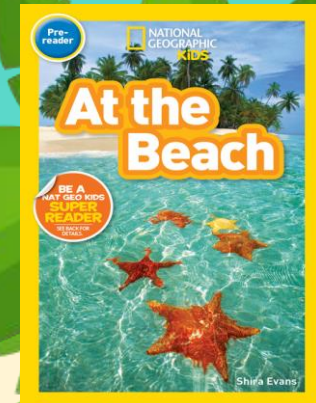

Seashell Snail Craft

Instructions

- 1) Cut your pipe cleaner in half, then half again. Take 2 of the remaining pieces, and bend them into L shapes.
- 2) Glue one end of each piece of pipe cleaner to the inside of the shell, along the 'top'. Bend the rest of each pipe cleaner up so that two 'eye stalks' are now peeking out of the shell.
- 3) Glue a Googly Eye to the free end of each pipe cleaner.
- 4) Glue one side of your large Pom-Pom to the inside of the shell, so that only part is peeking out of the opening.
- 5) All done! Feel free to paint your shell or leave it more natural looking.

Materials

- A sea shell
- 1 Large Pom Pom
- 1 Pipe Cleaner
- 2 Googly Eyes
