Teddy Bear Pencil Top

Materials

- Pom-poms (1 large, 3 small)
- Fuzzy Pipe Cleaner
- Scissors
- Glue
- Googly Eyes



Instructions

- 1) Twirl your fuzzy pipe cleaner around a pencil, leaving one end free to stick up and out.
- 2) Take a small pom-pom and draw a little nose and mouth on it with a black marker.
- 3) Glue the small pom-pom to center of the larger one. Glue the other small pom-poms on top and to the sides of the larger one, making the ears.
- 4) Glue the googly eyes to the large pom-pom too complete the bear.
- 5) Glue the bear to the free end of the pipe cleaner.
- 6) Let the glue dry, then you can add your fuzzy friend to every pencil you use from now on!
