Library Building Project Update

Work is finishing up at the Mastic Beach and Moriches neighborhood branches. For up to date information about the three-building bond project, please visit https://buildinginfo.communitylibrary.org/

The Mastic Beach Satellite Branch on Neighborhood Road is almost complete and will be open to the public by mid-January 2023. Staff is moving in and setting up furniture, collections and computers during December to get library services ready. It is 7,000 square feet on one level with ample parking, an outdoor program space, and a one-acre library park across the street. Keep an eye out on social media for a grand opening announcement in January!





The Moriches Satellite Branch is almost complete and features 7,000 square feet on one level with convenient parking and a huge outdoor yard for program space. We are awaiting delivery of the front door and a few other interior features. It is built in the same architectural style as the adjacent 95-year-old Little Red Schoolhouse. This branch is scheduled to be open sometime in February 2023.

Main Library Status - When the main library's exterior demolition was completed, engineers identified unanticipated issues — related to previous renovation projects — that require immediate remediation. The primary issues focus on ensuring

the structural integrity of the elevator shafts and making them ADA compliant, steel beams with insufficient support, as well as exterior wall fortification. These unforeseen issues will add time to the main building construction process.



While the cost of this remediation work has not been fully determined, the library cannot borrow more than the \$22.7-million-dollar amount authorized by voters. Moreover, the library trustees are committed to not going back to the community to ask for additional borrowing. Instead, we will be aggressively seeking private foundation and government grants, as well as working with the construction team to identify all available cost-saving options. Our goal is to deliver modern, state-of-the-art library buildings that the community deserves and needs.


