Doors opened Saturday, April 15, at the library's brand new Moriches Branch at 201 Montauk Highway. Moriches.



The opening brings "a level of geographic accessibility that's unprecedented in the district's history," said Kerri Rosalia, library director. "We are confident that the new Moriches library will be warmly embraced by area residents."

The news follows the Jan. 14 opening of the Mastic Beach Satellite Branch on Neighborhood Road. Since its opening, over 700 people have signed up with new library cards at the Mastic Beach branch. Additionally, 600 have asked that Mastic Beach serve as their "home library," officials said.

"The instant success of the Mastic Beach branch serves as a promising sign that the Moriches library will prove popular as well," said Joseph Maiorana, library board president.





In the meantime, the main branch in Shirley is undergoing an expansion, code-mandated safety renovations and technological modernizations. officials said. Main library services have been temporarily relocated to the Town of Brookhaven's Mastic Recreation Center at 15 Herkimer Street in Mastic.



NEW LIBRARY OPENS IN MORICHES

Moriches is home to a new library!

The grand opening was the second of two, back-to-back milestones for the district, following on the heels of the January 14 launch of a new, 7,000-square-foot Mastic Beach Satellite Branch at 369 Neighborhood Road.



The two brand-new branches now join the district's main library at 407 William Floyd Parkway in Shirley, which is undergoing code-mandated renovations and technological modernization.

Just like in Mastic Beach, the community has instantly and enthusiastically embraced the newly opened library. In just the first two weeks of operation there were more than 4,100 visitors to Moriches including 76 patrons that signed up for new library cards there with all asking that Moriches serve as their "home library."



The Moriches site offers ample parking and incorporates an expansive outdoor area suitable for both small and large outdoor programming.



A collection of popular reading materials, such as bestsellers, children's books, and DVDs, is housed in the Moriches building. Items requested from the main library, from the

Mastic Beach branch, or through interlibrary loan are available for pickup.

The library's flexible space includes dedicated areas for children, teens, and adults. The adult area offers seating for individual quiet work, multiple computers, and three program rooms. The children and teen areas have tables and chairs for students to do homework or study. There are dedicated computers for student use.

The Moriches library was designed to emphasize both cost savings and energy



efficiency. Just as in Mastic Beach, the overall Moriches site promotes sustainability by adhering to LEED standards set forth by the U.S. Green Building Council.



"Our library system is now achieving a level of accessibility that our community has never seen before," said Library Board President Joseph Maiorana. "Our library team places tremendous value on service, and our new geographic reach automatically translates into improved service."

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Exciting Progress Update on the Main Branch of the Mastics-Moriches-Shirley Community Library Construction Project

We are excited to bring you the latest updates on the construction progress being made at the main branch of the Mastics-Moriches-Shirley Community Library, located at 407 William Floyd Parkway in Shirley.

Interior Developments:

Significant progress has been made on the interior of the library. The installation of underground plumbing and electrical systems is now complete. Plumbing has already been backfilled, and concrete has been poured into the trenches. Fire sprinkler piping has been installed in the cellar level, and plumbing work will now focus on sanitary piping and roof drainage. Additionally, ductwork has begun on the lower levels.

Exterior Advancements:

The exterior of the library is also coming together nicely, with 90 percent of the exterior framing now complete. Roof level blocking, framing, and sheathing has begun, preparing the structure for the installation of a new roof, which has begun last month. The sheathing of exterior walls and weather barriers is well underway, while the cultured stonework started last month as well.

Structural Repairs:

As part of the remedial structural work, the damaged roof decking was replaced last month.


