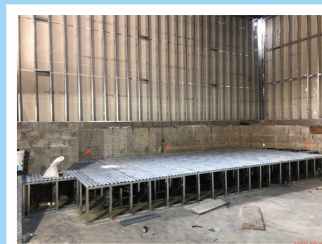


Project Update - Main Library

Interior Developments: Progress continues on the interior with fire sprinkler piping complete. On the lower levels, the stage in the large meeting room has begun to be constructed. Interior framing has begun, and the cellar walls are mostly framed out. The first area to be framed will be the basement. Mechanical, electrical & plumbing rough-ins will continue as framing progresses through the interior levels of the building.

Exterior Advancements: Exterior carpentry work will continue this month, with all walls framed and sheathed. The next work will be vapor barrier and siding installation. Exterior masonry work will continue over the next month. The old roof has been removed and replaced. With the completion of the flat roof, fire spraying work can now continue on the underside of the roof.

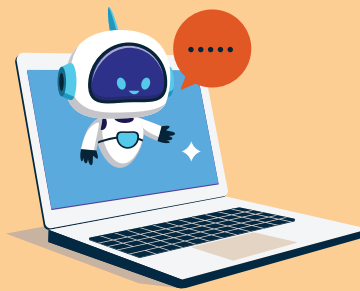


Artificial Intelligence Today
