PROJECT UPDATE - MAIN LIBRARY RENOVATION

We are pleased to report that steady progress is being made at the main library building.

Interior Progress: Interior fire spray work is complete, with just minor touch-ups pending. This will be finished after the full framing of the interior walls and completion of mechanical, electrical, and plumbing rough-ins, which continues to advance. Wall framing is ongoing across various sections of the building and is anticipated to conclude within the month, after which workers will focus on the ceiling and soffit framing. The fire sprinkler system has been roughed-in throughout the facility. In the coming weeks, we will begin removal of the existing antiquated sanitary system in preparation for the installation of a brand-new environmentally friendly I/A system.

Exterior Advancements: Carpentry work is in full swing and will be ongoing throughout the month. This includes the installation of the vapor barrier and the exterior siding. We are also nearing the finish line for exterior masonry work, which is slated to wrap-up in the next few weeks. In addition, spray foam installation has begun on all the exterior walls and is projected to be completed within the next two weeks.






Sunrise Wind Informational Table




