Code of Conduct

Prohibited in the Community Library:

- Disrespect toward library staff
- Weapons
- Food (16 oz. or smaller non–alcoholic bottled or covered beverages are permitted)
- Alcohol
- Smoking
- Sleeping
- Damaging or altering library property
- Disruptive behavior
 - Excessive noise
 - Foul language
 - Rough-housing
- Unhygienic conduct and/or activities that compromise the capacity of patrons to utilize the Library's facilities and services.
- Odor emanating from a patron/visitor that is so offensive so as to disrupt the capacity of others to utilize the Library's facilities and services.
- Utilizing the Library's public bathrooms for purposes other than those established lavatory ones such as by laundering clothes and bathing therein.
- Monopolizing Library space, equipment or outlets so as to preclude or limit the use thereof by other patrons/visitors.
- Leaving children unattended
- Talking on cell phones (Ringers must be silenced; texting is permitted)
- Adults or teens in children's areas without a child
- Bikes, shopping carts, skateboards, etc. inside the building

Required in the Community Library:

Wearing proper attire (including shirts, pants or shorts, and footwear) Keeping personal belongings with you at all times
