#### **Dear Library Patrons:**

In a world that feels ever-changing, one constant remains: our dedication to serving you, the heart of our community. We've navigated the challenges of our times, including persistent inflationary increases over the past three years and other economic pressures which have had a significant effect on the library. Despite it all, our commitment to providing top-quality library services is unwavering.

This year, we face the necessary step of proposing a 4.76 percent estimated tax increase, a decision not made lightly but with careful consideration for the future of our library and its patrons.

This increase, though above the state tax cap of 2 percent, translates to just \$32 estimated annually or a modest \$2.67 per month for the average household assessed at \$1,995. To put this in perspective, the increase is less than last year's inflationary food cost increase of 5.8 percent.\*

Central to our budget this year is the need to fairly compensate our staff, especially part-time custodians and parttime library clerks, roles crucial to our operation yet challenging to fill and retain. By adjusting these salaries, we aim not only to attract and retain dedicated employees but also to adapt to the state's minimum wage increase, ensuring our library remains a place of opportunity and growth.

Importantly, this proposed budget is totally separate from our capital building project, which continues to progress with the opening of our main library in Shirley anticipated this fall. Funded primarily by a previously approved bond, this project reflects our commitment to enhancing our facilities and making our community stronger, more resilient, and more connected than ever.

This year's proposed operating budget includes the costs associated with running three state-of-the-art facilities: the Main Library, set to open its doors in the third quarter of 2024, and our fully operational satellite branches in Moriches and Mastic Beach. This investment is vital not only for the maintenance and enhancement of our current services but also for ensuring that our newest addition the Main Library — will meet the high standards of excellent service and accessibility you've come to expect from us.

We understand that any increase in taxes is significant and want to assure you that this decision was reached with the utmost care and consideration for the impact on our community. We are here to answer your questions, provide clarity, and discuss any concerns you may have.

The estimated tax rate associated with the proposed operating budget is \$35.61 per \$100 of assessed valuation, which equates to an estimated annual levy of \$710 for an average household (based on an assessed valuation of 1,995).
