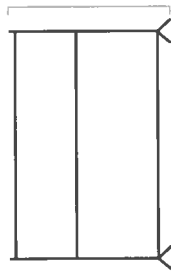


## MAXIMUM & MINIMUM HEIGHTS OF YOUR INSTANET

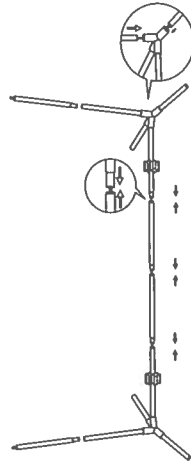

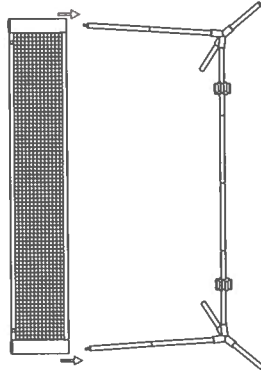
## ASSEMBLY

### AT MAXIMUM HEIGHT

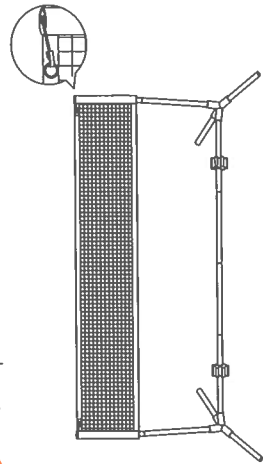
1 Connect all the poles to form the frame below.



2 Slide the net down over the steel poles.



3 Insert the hooks into the holes on top of the net to provide tension.



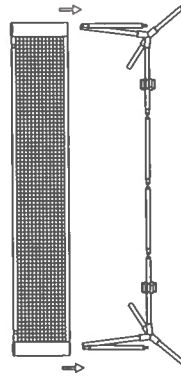
\*To use the net at MIDDLE height setting, release the tension hooks then slide the net down to desired height.

### AT MINIMUM HEIGHT

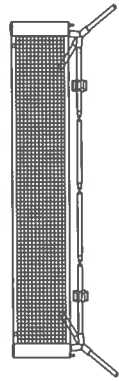
If you want to use the net at the lowest setting, leave the top poles disassembled.



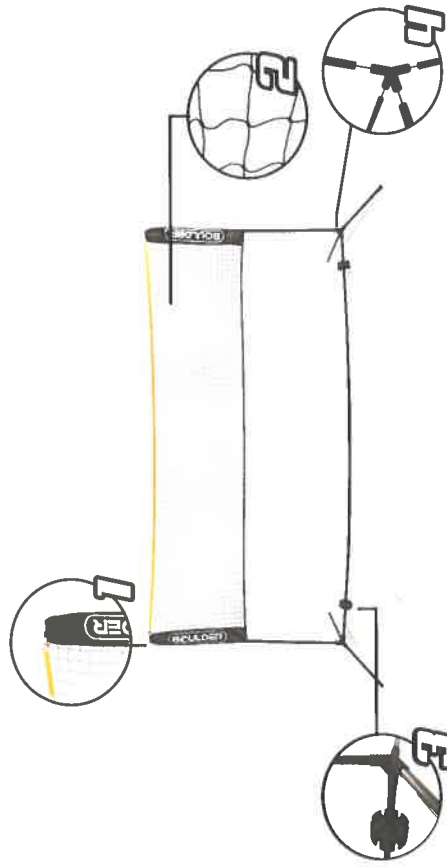
Slide the net down over the steel poles.



There is no need to use the net hooks as there is enough net tension at the lowest height setting.



## NET FEATURES



- 1. Net hooks and grommets** - provide optimal tension to keep top of the net taut
- 2. Net twine** - 1.3mm thick and UV-resistant to prevent fading
- 3. Steel frame** - 0.8mm thick, double the thickness of nearest competitors'. For added playing stability in windy weather and rough play
- 4. Bungee connectors** - single cord running through the frame allows for easy setup and storage

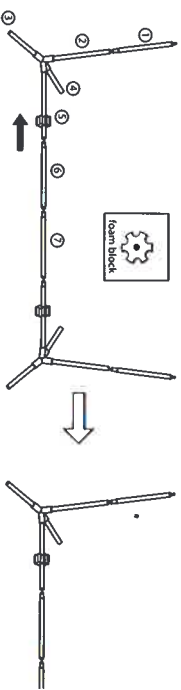

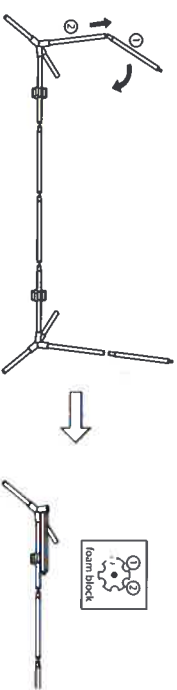
**Quick tip: if you don't have measuring tape, a dollar bill measures 1/2 foot! 1 foot = 12 inches.**

## DISASSEMBLY

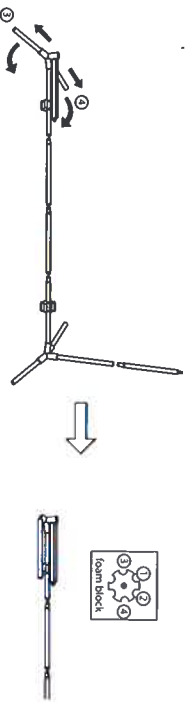
- 1 Start on one side - Slide the foam block so that it's in the middle of Pole 5. This will make it easier to fit all the poles on the block later on.



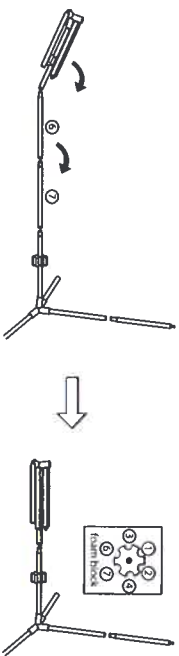
- 2 Disassemble Poles 1 and 2 and press them into adjacent slots on the foam block



- 3 Next, disassemble the feet (Poles 3 and 4) and press them into slots on either side of Poles 1 and 2 on the foam block



- 4 Finally, disassemble Poles 6 and 7 and press them into the remaining slots of the foam block.



- 5 Repeat all the steps on the other side. The organized poles will not perfectly align and this is normal. If you purchased the 17ft net, there will be poles that don't fit into the foam block and this is normal.

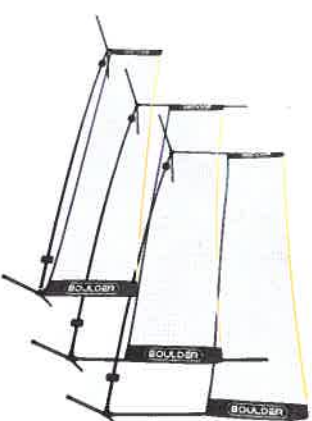

### Set the net high

Play badminton with your net set high. Your net is 5 feet tall, about the standard height for badminton.

It's also great for introducing volleyball to elementary kids (5-8 yrs old), seated chair volleyball, or casual volleying back and forth. It's 3 feet short for regulation volleyball so it's not intended for serious volleyball play.

### Set the net low

So many ways to play! Simply slide the net down to accommodate more sports like tennis, pickleball, or soccer tennis. Add some fun to the backyard, basement, beach, driveway, gym, camping site, and family holidays! Great for kids and adults of all ages.
