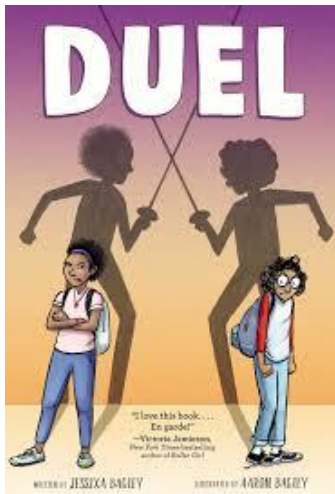


Call Me Iggy

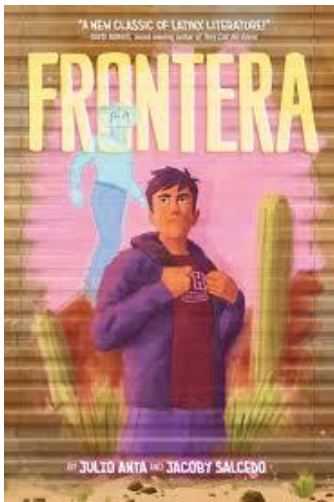


Duel

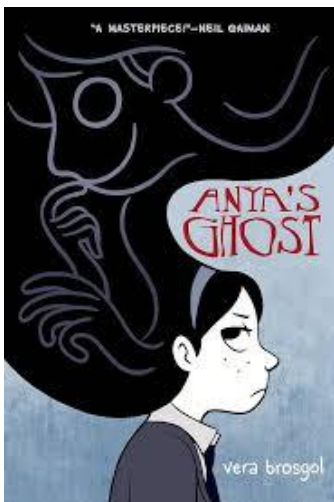


Frontera

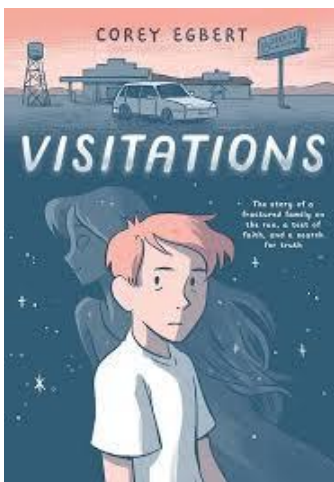


Anya's Ghost

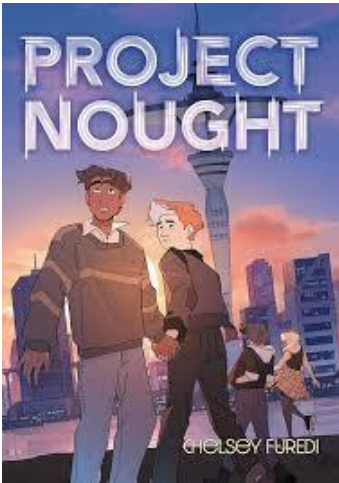


Visitations

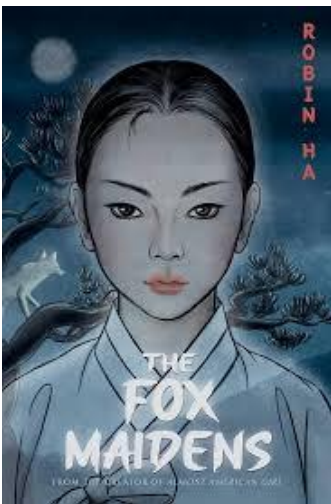


Project Nought

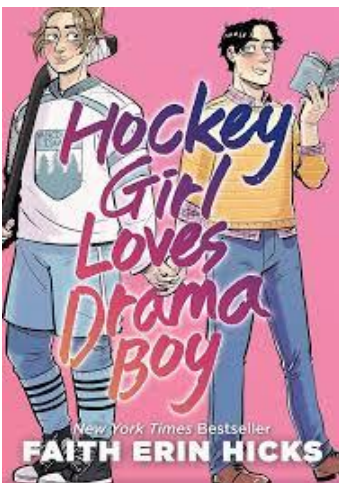

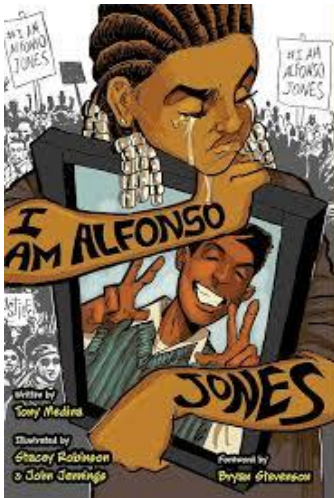

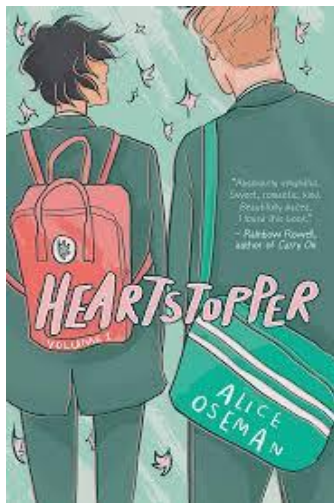


I am Alfonso Jones

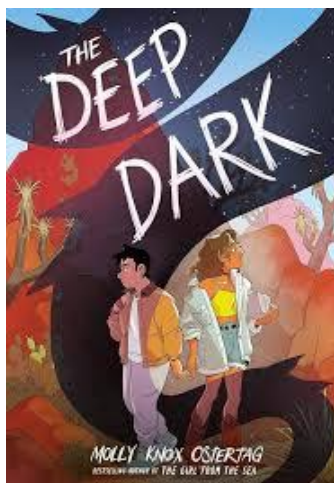


Heartstopper

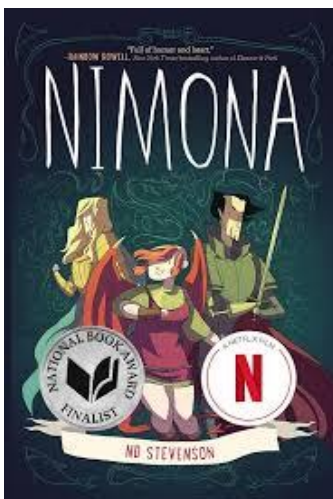


Thief of the Heights

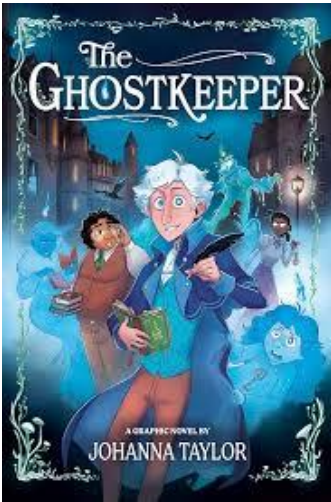


This One Summer

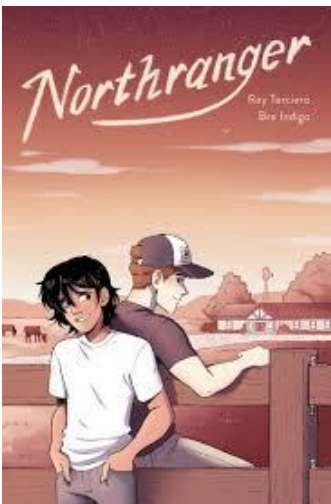


Brownstone

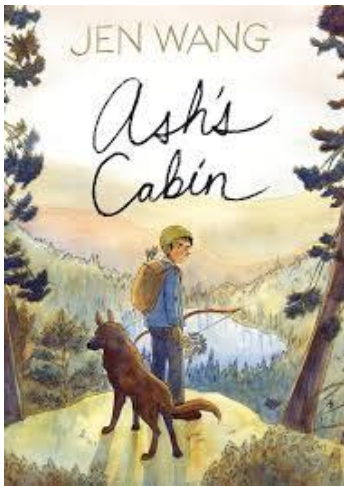


Mooncakes

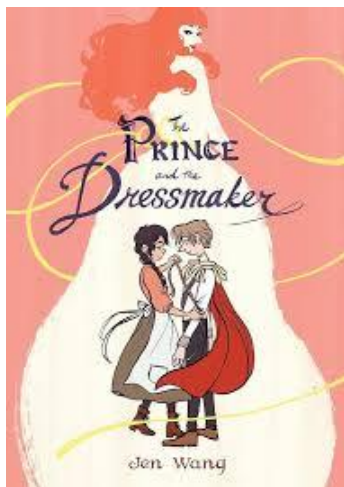


Ash's Cabin

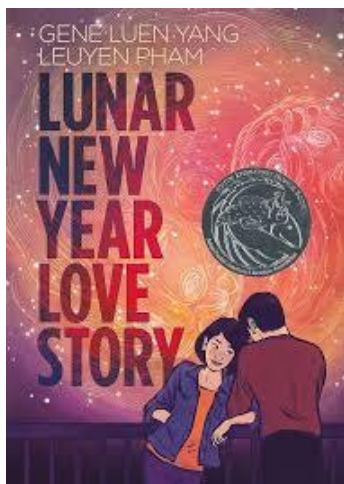


The Prince and the Dressmaker
